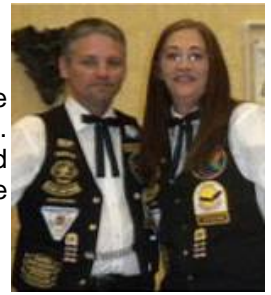

What Training is Available...Part III

In our continuing effort to let Florida GWRRA Members know what training is available through the Leadership Training Program, we will continue to describe the seminars available. The last two months we covered Chapter Life, Membership Orientation, Life Skills and Chapter Leadership Skills seminars. This month we are going to focus on the Intermediate and Advanced Leadership Skills areas.



Intermediate Leadership Skills

- **Building High Performance Teams:** Designed to increase the Officer's understanding of the concepts of teamwork and team building and provide an overview to teambuilding skills and group dynamics.
- **Financial Reporting:** Designed for participants to understand the importance of accurate and timely financial reporting, and the requirements and guidelines established by the IRS.
- **Motivating Volunteers:** Gain an insight into what motivates people in general and the uniqueness of how to best motivate volunteers.
- **Releasing Volunteer Leaders:** An increased understanding of the processes that govern releasing a volunteer Officer or Staff person from their position.
- **Chapter Communications Plan:** Communication within the Chapter is the road to success. Poor communications is the root cause of most problems.
- **Problem Solving:** Understand how to approach problem solving. Learn how to develop a problem solving strategy. Where you can get some help.
- **Win-Win Progress Reviews:** Gain an understanding of the purpose and intent of officer progress reviews. Develop a working knowledge of how to prepare for and conduct positive impact progress reviews.
- **FUNdraising:** To understand the basics of FUNdraising and to create a plan for successful FUNdraisers.

Advanced Leadership Skills

- **The Nature of Leadership:** Develop or refine existing leadership skills needed to serve the members. Develop the abilities of subordinate leaders. Increase self-awareness with respect to leadership characteristics.
- **High Impact Leadership Skills:** Gain a working knowledge of leadership characteristics. Understand the difference between leading and managing.
- **People Based Leadership Skills:** Increased understanding of the concepts involved in managing organization staffed by volunteers.
- **Leadership Survival Skills:** To provide GWRRA Leaders and Members with some of the key life skills they need to make the most of their experience as leaders and maximize their own personal potential.
- **Getting to Know Yourself:** Create a better understanding of ourselves as individuals.
- **Studies in Applied Leadership:** Share ideas and experiences of applied leadership and management techniques.
- **Coaching & Mentoring:** Understanding the importance of coaching. Analysis of learning and good coaching techniques.
- **Conflict Management:** Understand the nature of conflict. Develop skills to manage conflict and learn tools and techniques.

This coming month the Florida District Team will be heading back to Eufaula, Alabama for the Region Operations Meeting. During the meeting, we will get the latest information about the Region and GWRRA. The information we receive will be covered during the District's Chapter Conference. Speaking of the Chapter Conference, if you have not heard, it will be held on January 8th & 9th at the Radisson WorldGate in Kissimmee.

At the Chapter Conference we will be covering the required information for Officer's to maintain their status as Certified Officer. All people that attended the OCP during this year will need to attend and receive this information to maintain their certification. If anyone is unable to attend, you will need to contact us so we can ensure you receive and understand the information we will be putting out during the Chapter Conference.

In closing, we would like to wish everyone a happy and safe holiday season. We look forward to seeing everyone in 2011.
